

COMPARISON OF 2023 QUARTER I AND 2022 QUARTER I


NEW BUSINESS VOLUME:








1- Number of Employee and Profitability Per Employee






While the number of employees has been declining over the past 4 years, profitability ratio per employee has been changing over time.

Graph 2- Number of Employee and New Business Volume Per Employee






While the number of employees has been on downward trend since 2018 Quarter II, new business volume per employee ratios have been on upward trend since 2019 Quarter II.
